March 11, 2009

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**Call to Order**

The Pinal Regional Partnership Council Meeting was held on March 11, 2009 at Central Arizona College, 1211, 8470 N. Overfield Road, Coolidge, AZ 85228.

Regional Council Chair Mezzio called the meeting to order at 2:15 PM.

**Consent Agenda**

The items on the Consent Agenda included the Meeting Minutes from the January 14, 2009 and February 27, 2009 Pinal Regional Partnership Council Meeting.

A motion was made by Member O'Neil to adopt the January 14, 2009 meeting minutes, seconded by Member Powell. Motion approved.

The February 27, 2009 Meeting Minutes could not be approved at the Council Meeting due to discussion regarding verbiage. The February 27, 2009 Meeting Minutes will be in the Consent Agenda for approval at the April 8, 2009 Council Meeting.

**Update on First Things First Board Emergency Early Childhood Response Package**

The State First Things First office received an Arizona Department of Administration (ADOA) Bid Waiver to expedite discretionary funds in regards to access and affordability and family support. The Pinal Regional Partnership Council will tentatively receive 515.18 scholarships for children equaling \$1,051,610.06 dollars for a 3 to 4 month period. Eligible families will be 200% at/or below the federal poverty level and the centers need to be enrolled in *Quality First* and/or be accredited. The Council would like to consider cushioning more slots, after the time period has ended, but would like to wait

until more information (i.e. families affected by the cuts) is accumulated; only then will the Council possibly hold an Emergency Council Meeting to allocate more funds. The State funds will tentatively rollout on April 1, 2009.

February 18, 2009 – Priority waiting list will begin with all new clients (who are non-mandatory).

March 14, 2009 – Child care subsidy “drop” (below 165% - above 110% federal poverty level).

April 1, 2009 – Doubling and collapsing – doubling co-pay and collapsing for families with two or more children that receive a discount for siblings.

April 1, 2009 – Maximum reimbursement rate – 75% of the market rate survey 2000 + 5%, the 5% will be going away.

First Things First Food Boxes – The Statewide allocation is \$500,000.00. The Council will receive an update on how many food boxes the Pinal region will receive.

**Review to Pinal Regional Partnership Funding Plan in response to the Emergency Early Childhood Response Package**

Regional Councils had the choice to change, enhance or simply expedite strategies within the following areas, without state board approval: access and affordability and family support. The Council voted at the February 27, 2009 Council Meeting to expedite the family support strategy #7 (home visitation) using a bid waiver process.

Regional Councils had the choice to add funding allocations to the goal areas above from the following areas: needs and assets (\$50,000.00), evaluations (\$200,000.00), and communications (35% of \$17,500.00). The Council voted at the February 27, 2009 Council Meeting to move all funding from evaluations (\$200,000.00) and moved 35% from communications (\$17,500.00). The Council voted at the February 27, 2009 Council Meeting to move \$217,500.00 to the State First Things First food box program.

**Discussion and Possible Vote on the Pinal Regional Partnership Funding Plan in response to the Emergency Early Childhood Response Package**

The Council skipped this agenda item until they receive more information on the families affected by the cuts.

**Discussion and Possible Vote on Undistributed Pinal Regional Allocation**

Ms. Kempton-Sarosi recommended adding additional funding to the expedited home visitation strategy #7 due to the expanded time frame from 12 months to 16 months.

A motion was made by Member Gerkey to increase the funding allocation for strategy #7 (home visitation) from \$400,000.00 to \$500,000.00 (an increase of \$100,000.00), seconded by Member Allen. Motion approved. Conflict of Interest – Member O’Neil did not vote due to a conflict of interest. Additional work group meetings will take place to see if there are any further funding needs.
