
Number of Parents Provided with Parenting Education

840 Goal for 2011 - 2012




Goals for 2011 - 2012

- Expand and implement a marketing plan for the parenting education to increase participation and the average number of parents per class and workshop.
- Target education to parents and children “at risk” including foster parents, teen parents, single parents, parents in recovery, grandparents raising grandchildren and parents referred through the Court Systems.
- Increase parenting education opportunities in rural and outlying areas in Yavapai County.
- Expand the Kindergarten Fair in Prescott implemented by Del Webb Family Enrichment Center.



Goals for 2011 - 2012

- Increase the sub-contract with Buena Vista Children's Services to include parenting classes and a second Kindergarten Fair in Cottonwood.
- Continue to offer parenting class scholarships, covering the fees charges for eligible parenting education outside the classes offered through Youth Count.
- Diversify the topics covered through parenting workshops to include infant/toddler development, promoting literacy skills, foster parents/grandparents raising young children, fostering play, etc.
