WHEREAS, The San Carlos Apache Tribe is a federally recognized Indian Tribe organized Pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984); and,

WHEREAS, the San Carlos Apache Tribe has elected to form the San Carlos Apache Regional Partnership Council under 2006 Proposition 203, Arizona Early Childhood Development and Health Initiative; and

WHEREAS, the San Carlos Apache Regional Partnership Council has the responsibility of conducting an assessment, referred to as a Needs and Assets Report, that will identify the needs and assets available for early childhood development and health programs in the San Carlos region; and

WHEREAS, the San Carlos Apache Tribe approved the undertaking of such report via resolution number JUNE 08-103; and

WHEREAS, the San Carlos Apache Regional Partnership Council has completed the 2008 San Carlos Apache Region Needs and Assets Report and presented it to the San Carlos Apache Tribal Council on April 7, 2009 for review and comment; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the San Carlos Apache Tribal Council approves the publication and dissemination of the 2008 San Carlos Apache Region Needs and Assets Report.
