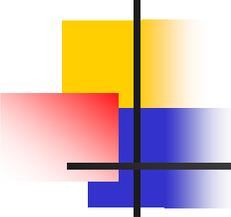





Help Child Care Providers:

- Provide health education for staff, children and their families.



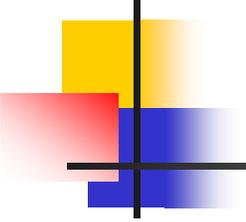
CCHC Role In Quality First Center/Home

- On going collaboration with Coaches on health and safety materials needed by Center/Home



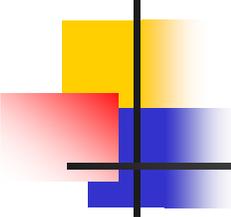
Health Education includes the following trainings:

- Disease Transmission



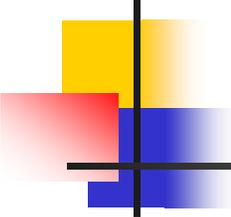
