
Pyramid Model of Tiered Service Delivery System

Services and Supports


- Universal **(blue)** – Services & supports for all children
- Targeted **(green)** – Services to reduce impact of risk factors for vulnerable children and families
- Intensive **(red)** – Specialized/focused services for children and families with additional needs



The following questions can guide our discussion of system building:

- Where do the strategies in our funding plan fall on the pyramid? Is this what we intended? Are we reaching the number of families desired and the target populations we identified?
- How do the collective strategies within each Goal Area build on each other to develop a service delivery network for children and families?
- How do our combined strategies work together to 1) achieve the desired outcomes, 2) compliment what exists within our region and 3) have a system impact (scope, reach, quality, alignment, and infrastructure)?
- What coordination and collaborative efforts are critical to achieving the outcomes desired in the SFY2011 funding plan as it relates to coordination and collaboration for individual strategies within the funding plan, overall for the region, and with other Regional Councils?
