The Council may request public comment specific to items on this agenda. Members of the public are reminded to observe proper decorum and only speak when recognized by the Council. Members of the public must also identify themselves each time they speak to assist with the taking of meeting minutes. Members of the public do not participate in any motions or votes.


