- AzCA has been providing Parents as Teachers in Arizona since 1999 and we currently have programs in Mohave, LaPaz, Pinal, Pima, Graham, and Greenlee Counties (and, of course, Yavapai!)

PAT Goals

- Increase Parent Knowledge of Early Childhood Development and Improve Parenting Practices.
- Provide Early Detection of Developmental Delays and Health Issues.
- Prevent Child Abuse and Neglect.
- Increase Children's School Readiness and School Success
