WHAT IS THE INTENT OF THIS FUNDING OPPORTUNITY?

The First Things First Navajo/Apache Regional Partnership Council (RPC) has identified the need for regional support for the use of the Arizona Parent Kit through family support programs, including home visitation programs.

Applications submitted in response to this RFGA must serve Navajo County and Apache County deducting the White Mountain Apache Tribe within Navajo and Apache Counties, deducting the Navajo Nation Tribe within Navajo and Apache Counties, deducting the Hopi Tribe, and deducting those zip codes that comprise the City of Winslow from Navajo County. The intended target population of this funding opportunity is parents of all newborns. Regional Partnership Councils may target additional target populations.

For the home visiting portion of the strategy, applicants must target families with children birth through age five living in the region, who **do not** meet eligibility requirements for another home-visiting program. The Council hopes to deliver services to 400 Families targeted during the first twelve months of implementation.

WHAT IS THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF FUNDING AVAILABLE?

Approximately \$139,788 is available in this Request for Grant Application. Contract renewal will be contingent upon satisfactory contract performance, evaluation and availability of funds.

The anticipated contract period for any resultant grant will be July 1, 2009 to June 30, 2010.
