WHAT IS THE FIRST THINGS FIRST NORTHEAST MARICOPA REGIONAL PARTNERSHIP COUNCIL COMMUNITY-BASED TEEN PARENT EDUCATION GRANT PROGRAM?

The Northeast Maricopa Regional Partnership Council would like to ensure that pregnant and parenting teens have the information and support they need to be effective parents. The Regional Council has identified the need for regional implementation of strategies to expand or establish a new parent education community based training program that supports pregnant and parenting teens in their ability to promote their children's optimal development and health and to provide access to information, resources, and high-quality social support.

The intended target population is pregnant and parenting teens and their children who reside within the geographic boundaries of Northeast Maricopa. The Northeast Maricopa Regional Partnership Council serves, and applications submitted in response to this RFGA must serve, the communities of Scottsdale, Paradise Valley, Fountain Hills, Carefree, Cave Creek, Rio Verde and Ft. McDowell Yavapai Nation, including zip codes 85250, 85251, 85252, 85253, 85254, 85255, 85256, 85257, 85258, 85259, 85260, 85261, 85262, 85263, 85264, 85266, 85267, 85268, 85269, 85271, 85377, 85327 and 85331. The portion of the Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community in zip code 85256 is not included. Applicants responding to this RFGA must be able to provide services throughout the region.

WHAT IS THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF FUNDING AVAILABLE?

Approximately \$100,000 is available in this Request for Grant Application. Contract renewal will be contingent upon satisfactory contract performance, evaluation and availability of funds.

The anticipated contract period for any resultant grant will be October 1, 2010 - to June 30, 2011.
