**WHAT IS THE FIRST THINGS FIRST SOUTH PIMA REGIONAL PARTNERSHIP COUNCIL
PUBLIC HEALTH INSURANCE OUTREACH AND ENROLLMENT ASSISTANCE GRANT
PROGRAM?**

The South Pima Regional Partnership Council has identified the need for regional implementation of programs to improve awareness and enrollment of families in appropriate public health insurance programs utilizing the Health-E-Application. This strategy requires outreach and education to parents about the importance of preventative health care guidelines. This strategy targets all families with children ages birth through five in the South Pima region. Specifically, the strategy targets children ages birth through five in the South Pima region who do not have public health insurance but who are eligible, or those who are currently enrolled in KidsCare and need to maintain that enrollment. Special attention may be needed for families in rural, more remote areas of the region.

WHAT IS THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF FUNDING AVAILABLE?

The total available funding for the period from May 1, 2010 – June 20, 2011 (14months) is approximately \$250,000. Contract renewal will be contingent upon satisfactory contract performance, evaluation and availability of funds.

The anticipated contract periods for any resultant grant include a two (2) month contract from May 1 through June 30, 2010 and a twelve (12) month contract from July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011. The estimate of funding that is available for the 2-month contract period is approximately \$50,000 with the amount estimated for the 12-month portion beginning on July 1, 2010 being approximately \$200,000.
