### **WHAT IS THE FIRST THINGS FIRST YAVAPAI REGIONAL PARTNERSHIP COUNCIL PARENT EDUCATION COMMUNITY-BASED TRAINING GRANT PROGRAM?**

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The Yavapai Regional Partnership Council would like to ensure that all families have the information and support they need to be effective parents. To accomplish this, the Regional Council has identified the need for regional implementation and expansion of community-based parenting education that supports parents to promote their children's optimal development and health.

The intended target population of this funding opportunity is parents and families with young children, birth through five years of age, living throughout the Yavapai Region. The Regional Partnership Council is especially interested in proposals that target underserved, high risk parents (e.g. teen parents, single parents, low-income families), or families living in communities that are currently underserved. The target number of Parent Education Programs to be provided is 20 classes per year, to serve approximately 200 parents and families with children, birth through five years of age.

### **WHAT IS THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF FUNDING AVAILABLE?**

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Approximately \$46,100 is available in this Request for Grant Application. Contract renewal will be contingent upon satisfactory contract performance, evaluation and availability of funds. The anticipated contract period for any resultant grant will be July 1, 2010 to June 30, 2011.
