Support to Working Families through Emergency Child Care Scholarships:

More than \$23 million dollars has been awarded to a consortium of United Ways to administer the FTF Emergency Child Care Scholarships. South Phoenix, Central Maricopa, South Pima, Cochise and Navajo/Apache Regional Partnership Councils also expedited \$920,472 for emergency scholarships.

Expedited Family Support Strategies to Promote Safe and Stable Home Environments:

Seventeen Regional Partnership Councils expedited \$12,021,352 to immediately help families with young children. FTF staff are working with the organizations below to finalize grant agreements which will go through June 30, 2010.
