

Population, 2010¹

- Total: 6,392,017
- Ages 0-5: 546,609

Ethnic Composition, 2010¹

- Hispanic: 30%
- White, non-Hispanic: 58%
- Black, non-Hispanic: 4%
- American Indian, non-Hispanic: 4%
- Asian or Pacific Islander, non-Hispanic: 3%
- Other, non-Hispanic: 2%


Household Composition¹

- Total households: 2,380,990
- Households with one or more children under 6 years: 384,441 (16%)
 - Husband-wife households: 250,217 (65% of households with children under 6)
 - Single-male householders: 43,485 (11% of households with children under 6)
 - Single-female householders: 90,739 (24% of households with children under 6)
- Average household size: 2.7

English ability for those who do not speak English at home (persons 5 and older)⁶

- Speaks English less than "very well": 11%
- Percent of households in which no person 14 and older speaks English (nor speaks "very well"): 6%

Grandparent Care¹

- Households with three or more generations: 115,549 (5%)
- About 74,153 children 0-5 are living in a grandparent's household (14%)

- Children 0-5: 24%



- Single female householder: \$26,377


Language Spoken at Home (persons 5 and older)⁶

Estimated School

Enrollment (ages 3-4)⁶

- Enrolled in public or private school: 34%
- Not enrolled in school: 66%

Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program Participation (July 2011)²

- 216,398 (40% of children 0-5)

Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Participation (July 2011)²

- 12,837 (2% of children 0-5)

Free and Reduced Lunch Eligibility³

- Arizona Statewide Average: 66%

Women, Infants and Children Participation (2011)²

- Arizona: 251,531 (55% of children 0-4)

Educational Attainment (ages 25 and older)⁶

- Did not finish high school: 15%
- High school or GED: 25%
- Greater than high school: 60%

Additional Birth Data (2009)⁴

- First Trimester Prenatal Care: 80% of all births
- Teen Births: 12% of all births
- Public Payer Births: 55% of all births
- Low Birth Weight: 7% of all births

Infant Mortality (2000-2009)^{4, 5}

- Arizona: 6.7 per 1,000⁴
- Healthy People 2020 goal: 6.0 per 1,000⁵

Immunizations⁴

- Completion of recommended series, 12-24 months: (70% of children 12-24 months)
- Completion of recommended series, 19-35 months: (41% of children 19-35 months)

Health Insurance^{4, 6}

- AHCCCS⁴: 21.8% of the population is enrolled (all ages)
- Percent Uninsured, 0-5⁶: 11%

AIMS Scores (Statewide Average)³

Reading Scores (3rd grade)

- Falls far below standards: 5%
- Approaches standards: 19%
- Meets or exceeds standards: 76%

Math Scores (3rd grade)

- Falls far below standards: 10%
- Approaches standards: 22%
- Meets or exceeds standards: 68%
