

- Other, non-Hispanic: 3%


Community Households¹

- Children 0-5: 16%





Enrollment (ages 3-4)⁶

- Enrolled in public or private school: 2%
- Not enrolled in school: 98%

Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program Participation (July 2011)²

- Mohave Valley: 224 (49% of children 0-5)

- Low Birth Weight: 6% of all births

- Mohave Valley: Not available
- Mohave County: 7.4 per 1,000⁴
- Arizona: 6.7 per 1,000⁴
- Healthy People 2020 goal: 6.0 per 1,000⁵

Immunizations⁴

- Completion of recommended series, 12-24 months: 23 (51% of children 12-24 months)
- Completion of recommended series, 19-35 months: 25 (35% of children 19-35 months)

AIMS Scores (Mohave Valley Elementary District)³

Reading Scores (3rd grade)

- Falls far below standards: 8%
- Approaches standards: 27%
- Meets or exceeds standards: 65%

Math Scores (3rd grade)

- Falls far below standards: 19%
- Approaches standards: 21%
- Meets or exceeds standards: 60%
